### **Talking Points**

Most kids diagnosed with cancer go on to survive through adulthood but experience significantly reduced quality of life and enormous health risks for everything from heart disease and obesity to secondary cancers and early death.

MaxLove Project's goal is to ensure that every kid diagnosed with cancer thrives against the odds.

**MLP** is <u>the only</u> childhood cancer non-profit that focuses exclusively on improving quality of life and reducing long-term health risks for all families affected by childhood cancer. MLP works to achieve maximum quality of life for childhood cancer families through 1) tailored cooking classes; 2) whole-family wellness kits; 3) targeted peer social support; and 4) professionally designed, facilitated, and evaluated health and wellness programs.

**MLP's mission is to increase the quality of life and reduce long-term health risks** for families surviving childhood cancer, related pediatric rare diseases, and chronic hospitalizations. We empower families fighting childhood cancers and related life-threatening conditions with quality-of-life care, fierce foods, whole-body wellness resources, education and research. We believe that true health starts when families are empowered to be active partners in their child's healing.

At MaxLove Project, we invest in hope. Today, nearly 85% of all children diagnosed with some cancers survive beyond 5 years. While this is great news for many, the fight for most is never over. Researchers now know that the treatments that save lives also increase later risks for serious, life-threatening illnesses. These health risks are lifelong, increase with age, and can result in early death. This is why we're kickstarting our own wellness revolution, one specifically for kids and families fighting cancer and the lifelong effects of cancer treatment.

We believe that all kids should have full access to every cancer-fighting tool available, including excellent nutrition and therapeutic resources such as acupuncture, physical activity, and healing narratives. Teaming up with a diverse group of doctors, nurses, dietitians, chefs, farmers, integrative medicine practitioners and artists, MaxLove Project equips families to thrive within the pediatric healthcare system of today—where the standard of care for most life-limiting illnesses does not include essential integrative therapies—as we work to change the system of tomorrow.
